The mission of the Lamar University Police Department (LUPD) is to ensure a safe and secure atmosphere for learning. Through the use of various policing tactics and resources the LUPD safeguards life, protects property, enforces the law, and upholds the rights of all citizens. Keeping an open channel of communication between the LUPD and the community allows us to maintain the highest possible standards. Feedback is always welcome and affords us opportunities for improvement or recognition.

Texas Law requires that all complaints against police officers be in writing and signed by the person making the complaint (Texas Government Code 614.022). Complaints should be made by the person directly affected as soon as possible after the event; other persons may provide statements as witnesses. A valid complaint regarding our services or personnel initiates an impartial inquiry and potential investigation by the LUPD. If you have a complaint involving an LUPD employee, provide their name, badge number, and vehicle number. Provide the date, time, location, and explanation what occurred—to the best of your recollection. Submit your original signed and notarized Praise & Complaint form to the Lamar University Police Department;

- In person at the LUPD station,
- Mail the signed and notarized original to Hector A. Flores, Chief of Police at the address above, or
- You may call LUPD and ask for a supervisor; any over the phone complaint must be signed in person

## What happens next?

*Praise*: The employee may be recognized with a special announcement or a commendation from the department. *Complaint*: When the inquiry into the matter is completed, you will be notified of the resolution of your complaint.
